PARTICIPATION

This tournament is open to all members of the Dutch Bowling Federation and members with an IBF licence up to the age 25 years. (NBF rules 527 applies)

FORMAT

PRELIMINARY ROUNDS: Entry en re-entry(ies): All categories play 6 games preliminary round, Amerikaans style, 2 players per lane.

DESPERADO: 1 game, 1 player per lane, European style. Registration for Desperado 1 hour before start.

SEMI FINALS: All categories play 4 games, Amerikaans style, 2 players per lane, 9 players qualify. Scores, bonus included are carry

FINALS: All categories play 4 games, Amerikaans style, 4 players qualify. Scores, bonus included are carry forward.

In accordance with Article 528, NBF Sporting Regulations, final positions that have fallen vacant will not be filled.

MASTERS: Winners categories 1 to 4 play 1 game Amerikaans style, **highest game thrown wins the masters**

SQUADS FORMATS:

SQUAD CRITERIA AND CLASSIFICATION

Foreign participants play their entry and re-entry(ies) in the 2nd weekend.

The squads in the first weekend are reserved for participants from the Netherlands. It is not allowed to register for the 2nd weekend if you live within a radius of 250 kilometres from the bowling centre.

The above rule applies until 1 month before the tournament starts. For the available open spots at that time, anyone can register.

After registration, relocation is possible only after consultation with organisation.

The requested squads will be awarded as far as possible, however the organisation reserves the right to deviate from this if necessary (e.g. in case of too few participants).

NO UNNECESSARY DELAYS DURING SQUADS, SEMI FINALS, FINALS AND MASTERS:🚫

After the player to your right and/or left has left the approach, you must start your own throw within 30 seconds, in order to avoid unnecessary delay, in accordance with the NBF Sanctions Policy Art. 224 paragraph 3 and 225, paragraph 1 and Art. 241 Sanctions. A two lane courtesy is not allowed.

RE-ENTRY(IES)

Is allowed **twice!** During the tournament this is only possible if there is still room in squads.

A player, who made a reservation for a / or re-entry(ies), will be obligated to pay for this re-entry(ies).

Should you decide not to play a / or re-entry(ies) after the first preliminary round, you will not receive any money back.

For all National and International participants, the score of the entry and re-entry(ies) will be passed to the NBF.

COACHING to be announced at registration

Bowlers should indicate, at registration, whether they are using a trainer/coach. This trainer/coach must be certified

REGISTRATION

Registrations can only be made on the website: www.juniordutchopen.com

Registration for the Junior Dutch Open is official when payment for the entry/re-entry(ies) via website has been received and confirmed by the organisation.

The participant has the right to cancel his/her booked entry and/or re-entry(ies) up to 14 days after receipt without giving reasons.

Entry fees must be paid at all times.

PRESENCE

Players must register at least 45 minutes before the start of their squads and finals at the tournament secretariat.

(Article 226 NBF sporting regulations)

TOURNAMENT RULES

RULES

The general playing and tournament rules of both the Dutch Bowling Federation (NBF Sporting Regulations) and EBF will govern this tournament

SANCTIONED

This tournament is sanctioned by the Dutch Bowling Federation: Sanction No. 2024/A207 – Class 2, international approval EBF.

TIE: In accordance with NBF rule art. 218-1-2-3 paragraph c:

Preliminaries: In the event of a tie after preliminary rounds, the player with the highest last game including bonus will proceed to the quarter finals. If this is also equal, the second last game applies, etc. etc.

Desperado: If there is a tie for a place in the semi-finals, a 9th and 10th frame will be played until the tie is broken.

Semi-final: If a tie is decisive for a place in the final then a 9th and 10th frame will be played until the tie is broken.

Final: If there is a tie, a 9th and 10th frame will be played until the tie is broken.

Masters: If there is a tie, a 9th and 10th frame will be played until the tie is broken.

CHECKING THE RESULTS/SCORES: Any complaint about the correctness of the scores must be made to the tournament management within 10 minutes of the official announcement.

PLAYERS' AREA - COACHING

The players' area is defined as the area from the start of the approach up to the walkway behind the players' seating area.

It is not allowed to eat or drink in the players' area.

Coaches: who are registered and certified will receive a badge, to be recognisable for organisation and competition management.

BOWLING LICENSE AND AVERAGE:

Age on 1 September of 2023 determines classification.📄

If required, identification should be presented to confirm date of birth. In accordance with Article 310 NBF sports regulations.📄

RESPONSIBILITY:

Players, coaches, parents and/or supervisors are responsible for ensuring that the bowling equipment does not pose a danger to other players or those present in the bowling centre. The organisation is not responsible for any loss or damage to bowling equipment or related items.

Important:

It is not allowed to consume your own co-brought consumables inside the bowling centre.

DRESS CODE: Wearing bowling clothes is compulsory throughout the tournament and prize-giving ceremony. (bowlershirt with their names on it).

Coaches wear a bowling shirt so that it is recognisable who or which group they are coaching, within the players' area they wear bowling (or sports) shoes.

Wearing jeans, jogging clothes, as well as wearing caps in any form is not allowed.

If you have a medical or demonstrable reason please discuss this with the tournament leader.

PHONE / TABLETS: The use of mobile phones, Ipads, tablets (must be switched off) by participants is not permitted within the players' area during the entire tournament.

CODE OF CONDUCT: JUNIOR DUTCH OPEN and NBF apply to this tournament, for information see:

Prizewinners have to be present at the award ceremony. Prizes won will not be awarded prematurely unless it can be proven that the player has to leave the tournament due to unforeseen circumstances.📄

DECISION-MAKING: In all cases not provided for in these rules, the tournament management will decide.
