PARTICIPATION:

This tournament is open to all members of the Dutch Bowling Federation and members with an IBF licence up to the age 25 years.

REGISTRATION:

Registration via the website: www.juniordutchopen.com

Your registration for the 4th Storm Junior Dutch Open is official once the deposit for the entry/entries has been received and confirmed by the organisation. Cancellation of reserved entries is possible until 15th of July 2026.

We kindly request that you pay the specified deposit after registering your entry and/or re-entries. This deposit guarantees your participation. You will receive a link for the remaining payment for your reserved squads **3 months** before the start of the tournament. Your reserved entry and re-entries must be paid for before the start of the tournament.

Each participant has the right to cancel his/her booked entry and/or re-entry(ies) up to 14 days after receipt without giving any reason. **Refunds within this period will be made in accordance with our general terms and conditions. Entry fees must be paid at all times.**

FORMAT

PRELIMINARY ROUNDS: 6 games AM for all age categories - two re-entries per player allowed, max. 3 players per lane, 6 players per category qualify for the semi-finals. Scores will be carried forward to the finals.

SEMI-FINALS: 4 games AM for all age categories, 2 players per lane, 4 players per category qualify for the finals. Scores from preliminary rounds are carried forward.

FINALS: 3 games AM for all age categories, 1 player per lane, winners advance to the masters. Scores semi finals are carried forward.

MASTERS: Winners Cat. 1-6 B/G play separately 1 game AM, highest game B/G wins the masters. **Scores reset to zero!**

Final positions that have fallen vacant will not be filled.

SLOW BOWLING / NO UNNECESSARY DELAYS DURING THE TOURNAMENT:

The tournament leader will not allow unreasonable delays in the progress of a game. To prevent this, a one-lane courtesy is observed. The rule that is enforced shall be: a player shall enter the approach and immediately get ready to execute his/her throw at the moment that the player on the lane to his/her right has released his/her ball at the foul line and no player is ready to execute the throw on the lane immediately to his/her left. If a bowler refuses to continue a game after being urged to do so by the tournament leader, that game will be considered invalid.

RE-ENTRY(IES): Allowed twice! During the tournament, this is only possible if there is still space available in any squads. A player who has made a reservation for one or two re-entries is obliged to pay for these re-entries. If you decide not to play your re-entry or second re-entry after your initial entry and/or re-entry, you will not receive a refund for your registration fees. If you are able to transfer this re-entry to another player, you can receive a refund for the registration fee(s) you paid from that player.

RESPONSIBILITY: Players, coaches, parents and/or supervisors are responsible for ensuring that the bowling equipment does not pose a danger to other players or those present in the bowling centre. The organisation and the bowling centre are not liable for the loss of or any damage to bowling equipment or related items.

Important: It is not allowed to consume your own brought refreshments inside the bowling centre.

PRESENCE: Participants must register at least 45 minutes before the start of their squad(s) and finals at the tournament office. **Finals will start as soon as lane maintenance is complete, so please arrive on time.** 🕒

TOURNAMENT RULES

RULES: The competition rules of the EBF and IBF and the tournament rules S.J.D.O. will govern this tournament.

TOURNAMENT APPROVAL: This tournament has approval no.2026/A440, International EBF and IBF approval.

NO-URETHANE: Urethane balls are not permitted. All bowling balls must have been manufactured on or after 1 August 2022. For more information about balls that are not permitted, see: <https://juniordutchopen.com/wp-content/uploads/2025/11/Ball-list-SJDO-2026-Eng.pdf>

COACHING: When registering, please indicate whether you will be using a trainer/coach who is EBF Level II fully qualified and certified by the EBF.

TIE: Preliminaries: The highest positioned athlete will be the athlete scoring the highest last game. If a tie still exists, the highest positioned athlete will be the athlete with the highest second last game etc.

Semi-finals: A tie in a match will be broken by playing a 9th and 10th frame roll off, repeated until the tie is broken.

Finals: A tie in a match will be broken by playing a 9th and 10th frame roll off, repeated until the tie is broken.

Masters: A tie in a match will be broken by playing a 9th and 10th frame roll off, repeated until the tie is broken.

SCORE CHECK: Any complaint about the correctness of the scores must be made to the tournament management within 10 minutes of the official announcement.

BOWLING DRESS CODE: Wearing bowling clothes, shirt (player's name), is compulsory throughout the tournament and prize-giving ceremony. ***Wearing jeans-, jogging clothes, as well as wearing caps in any form is not allowed.*** If you have a medical or demonstrable reason please discuss this with the tournament director.

PHONES / TABLETS: The use of mobile phones and tablets by participants is not permitted in the players' area during the entire tournament.
